What happens inside an egg?


Touch the pink buttons and see what happens.

What happens inside an egg


Here is a tiny speck that will grow into a baby bird.




The chick grows slowly inside the egg.

When it is hatched, the chick eats solid food such as corn, seeds and grubs.







What happens inside an egg

Crocodiles and alligators leave their eggs to be hatched out by the warmth of the sun.


The crocodile grows for nearly three months inside its egg, but takes only two hours to hatch out.

It pushes its snout through the skin in the egg.

Then, it twists and turns and bores its baby-tooth through the shell.
